



Coronavirus (COVID-19): Rapid testing consent form for pupils under 16

This form explains the reasons Loxford School Trust is asking your child to undergo routine testing for coronavirus (COVID-19). The form also explains how we will process your child's information. Please read the form thoroughly and indicate your consent where appropriate

What is Coronavirus Rapid Result Testing?

To assist in the government's goal to limit the spread of coronavirus and safeguard the health and safety of all staff and pupils, we will be offering on-site testing to staff and pupils, even if they are not showing symptoms of coronavirus - this is because it is possible to unknowingly spread the virus while being asymptomatic.

Why do we need your consent?

Please note that participation in these rapid result tests is entirely **voluntary**. Without your consent to undergo these tests, we will be unable to administer them, or use your child's data for the NHS Test and Trace purposes.

Those who decline to participate in the rapid-result tests are still required to follow national guidelines and must self-isolate for 10 days if they present with symptoms of coronavirus, test positive for coronavirus, or are identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive.

What data is collected?

To process the rapid-result test we require the following data:

- Name of student to be tested
- Year Group
- Name of parent or guardian if under 16
- Email Address of parent
- Mobile Number
- Date of birth of child
- First Line of address and postcode
- Date
- Relationship to child if under 16

How will we use your data?

We will use your data for the following reasons:

- To provide the NHS Test and Trace service with notification of positive results
- To help identify close contacts
- To record when rapid- result testing has been administered

The results of your child test will remain confidential at all times

When does my consent expire?

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. Consent will be refreshed if any test administration or data management processes change.

You must inform the school, in writing, if your consent needs to be withdrawn or amended. The school will retain your/your child's data until you withdraw your consent, or your child leaves the school.
